### New opportunities in reproducibility and replicability with examples from environmental psychology

#### Abstract

Psychologists are grappling with how quickly to adopt and teach new methods on transparency and reproducibility. I will share my experiences of trying some of the recommended changes. I will describe publishing a replication in collaboration with your department, three Registered Reports, and an open list of free, large datasets (N=152) across all of psychological science with descriptive metadata: [bit.ly/2FifRWp](https://bit.ly/2FifRWp) doi:10.17605/OSF.IO/TH8EW. Scientists often don't know what data already exists or how to use it without a huge time investment. Students also feel pressure to find results in underpowered thesis projects. I will argue why this open data is needed, give examples of how to use it for classroom teaching and supervision, and show connections to our latest results in environmental psychology.

#### About the Speaker

Cameron Brick is an Assistant Professor of Social Psychology at the University of Amsterdam, Netherlands. He studies how individuals react to collective problems such as climate change, and uses surveys and experiments to predict behavior from thoughts, identities, personalities, and social context.
