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### **Abstract**

To make a meaningful contribution to a particular field of research, one needs an effective and efficient workflow for reviewing the rapidly growing body of literature. This roundtable discussion focuses on good practices that the three panel members have organically developed and deployed. All three members have, as a result, published impactful review papers in journals such as Psychological Bulletin, Personality and Social Psychology Review, and Trends in Cognitive Science. The panel members will give a brief sharing of their "method" in doing comprehensive yet critical literature reviews (i.e., how to read, take notes, and come up with something worth writing a review paper about). The discussion will also touch upon lessons they have learned along the way, and tips and tricks that might be helpful to the audience. We invite the audience to also share their successes as well as struggles. There is no gold standard or right way to do literature reviews; this roundtable merely aspires to inspire you to come up with one that suits you.
