Deepening Participation In The Science Of Neurodivergence: What Have We Learnt From RE-STAR

ABSTRACT

Participation by neurodivergent people in the science of neuro-developmental conditions such as ADHD and autism is now viewed as essential. However, it is often limited to arms-length advice from boards organised outside the study itself. RE-STAR has developed a new model placing neurodivergent people at the heart of the research process - moving from advisors to investigators. In this talk I describe this general model, its implementation, and the way it has invigorated our study of adolescent mental health and neurodivergence.

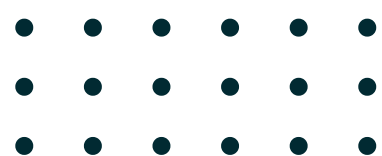
